Position Summary

Each Nurse Practitioner (NP) works with 2 focused areas of service including providing primary health care for a roster of clients at the centre and providing primary health care for outreach clients within the Brantford downtown.

The Nurse Practitioner will function with an integrated team of professionals that offer primary care including: assessment and development of treatment plans in collaboration with the client, caregiver, and referrals as required. This integrated role also provides flexible outreach services to vulnerable of all ages who may be at risk of homelessness, and who may have addiction, and /or mental health challenges.

This position will be required to work evenings and occasionally a weekend.

Requirements:

- · Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing required, Master of Science in Nursing preferred
- · Current registration with the College of Nurses as a Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner required
- · Demonstrated experience in Community and Mental Health and Addictions
- · Ability to work autonomously as part of a multi-disciplinary team
- · Knowledge and proficiency in current, evidenced-based methods and practices of primary care delivery, with an emphasis on health promotion and harm reduction
- · Superior leadership, organization, research, evaluation, time management, communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience working with electronic medical records (EMR)
