

Nurse Practitioner-Brantford Downtown Outreach Team 18 month contract FT

The Nurse Practitioner (NP) collaborates with members of an interdisciplinary team to provide primary health care and mental health and addictions services as part of a Street Outreach Team. Specific functional areas of responsibility for the Nurse Practitioner include (but are not limited to) primary health care assessment and development of treatment plans in collaboration with the client, caregiver, and outreach staff as required.

The outreach team will function as an integrated team of professionals that offer flexible outreach services to vulnerable, street involved individuals of all ages who may be at risk of homelessness, and who may have addiction, and/or mental health challenges. The team will largely be operating in a mobile capacity in and around Brantford's downtown.

This position may be required to work occasional evenings and weekends.

Requirements:

- Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing required, Master of Science in Nursing preferred
- Current registration with the College of Nurses as a Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner required
- Demonstrated experience in Community and Mental Health and Addictions
- Ability to work autonomously as part of a multi-disciplinary team
- Knowledge and proficiency in current, evidenced-based methods and practices of primary care delivery, with an emphasis on health promotion and harm reduction
- Superior leadership, organization, research, evaluation, time management, communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience working with electronic medical records (EMR) preferred
