Position Summary

The Nurse Practitioner (NP) collaborates with members of an interdisciplinary team to provide health care and mental health and addictions as part of the Rapid Access Addiction Medicine (RAAM) team. Specific functional areas of responsibility for the Nurse Practitioner include (and are not limited to), health assessment, diagnosis, therapeutics, and the development of comprehensive treatment plans in collaboration with the client, family and other RAAM staff as required.

The RAAM clinic operates as an integrated multidisciplinary team for the treatment of mental health and addictions. The Nurse Practitioner will be working across Brant, Brantford, Haldimand and Norfolk.

Requirements:

- · Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing required, Master of Science in Nursing preferred
- · Current registration with the College of Nurses as a Primary Health Care NP required
- · Demonstrated experience in Community and Mental Health and Addictions
- · Ability to work autonomously as part of a multi-disciplinary RAAM team
- · Knowledge and proficiency in current, evidenced-based methods and practices of primary care delivery, with an emphasis on health promotion and harm reduction

- · Experience working with electronic medical records (EMR) preferred
