Position Summary

We are currently seeking a Peer Worker to join our Inter-professional Primary Care Team (IPCT). The members of the IPCT work collaboratively to provide primary care services to registered and non-registered clients of GRCHC, in various settings (at the CHC, on the CHC community health bus, at partner agencies or outdoors in the community) with a specific focus on marginalized populations.

As a member of the IPCT, the Peer Worker will: provide on-site and outreach peer support for IPCT clients, work with clients to complete forms or documentation, provide harm reduction education, meet clients in the community to provide support as needed, work with the IPCT staff team to execute program improvements and changes, and other tasks as required. The role will also involve community engagement at all stages of program development. The Peer Worker will be using personal/lived experience and/or knowledge of street involved lifestyle to support the IPCT program and clients.

Hours of work- primarily days; to include some evening, weekend work as required.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 2 years of volunteer or work experience in a peer support role.
- Demonstrated experience in harm reduction and alignment with harm reduction philosophy/ principles.
- Experience accessing or supporting access to community addictions, harm reduction, and/or mental health services.
- Strong skills in communications, interpersonal relations, and conflict de-escalation.
- Demonstrated knowledge of social/ health services in the Brantford-Brant region

A competitive salary, of \$23.72 – \$28.56 per hour and benefits (including HOOPP) are offered.

The successful candidate will be required to provide a police vulnerable sector check as a condition of employment, consideration may be given depending on the nature of the offense. Please note that all new hires are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition of employment.
